Treasurer's Report By- M. Tears:

• The balance as of September 30, 2024 is \$1,159,743.25 of which includes the CD total of \$447,000., total Stock \$121,696.08 and total cash of \$459,774.17.

Old Business:

Electric Bicycle Batteries/Charges:

- During the October 30th Standing Committee meeting, the Architectural Committee expressed concerns regarding storage of electric bicycle batteries and chargers due to fire hazards.
- A request was made for further investigation regarding local ordinances. Legislation and association insurance requirements.
- Attorney response as follows:
 - N.J.A.C 39:4-14.16, would require the Association to allow the use of low-speed electric bicycles or low-speed electric scooters on the streets, roadways and bicycle paths. (Low speed electric bicycles and low-speed electric scooters are those with a maximum speed of 20 miles per hour. N.J.S.A. 39:191. They must have a label permanently affixed, in a prominent location, containing the classification number, top assisted speed and motor wattage.)
 - o If the Association is concerned about storage of electric bicycles because of the fire hazard they have been reported to present, there are some options available; The Association could require that all electric bikes and scooters have the UL Certification. This will provide some assurance that the drivetrain, battery system and charger are in safe, proper working order. Notwithstanding, a hazard still exists if people charge them in close proximity to flammable items in the home and/or use outlets/circuits not designed for charging these items.
 - o I recommend UL Certification requirement.
- Information to be provided to the Architectural Committee for review.
- Committee recommendations will be forwarded to the board.
