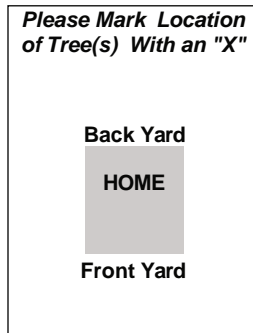

- You **MUST** fill out an Architectural application stating the species of tree you will be replacing the tree with, or you will not be able to obtain the **REQUIRED** Brick Township Permit.
- Once the application is approved by the Architectural Committee You **MUST** bring your LHSA **"Approved"** Application with you to the township office.
- When the township permit is obtained, you **MUST** bring it into the office to be copied into your property file, and to receive your LHSA Permit to display in your window.
- When the tree(s) is/are **REMOVED**, you **MUST** notify the office.
- When the the tree(s) is/are **PLANTED**, the **LHSA permit is to be returned to the office** to record in your property file that the replacement requirements have been completed.

**These permit requirements have been mandated by Brick Township Law.**

Replacement trees must be a minimum height of **7 feet above ground**, planted and be of a type which conforms with LHSB Bylaws Architectural Regulation XI, 6, page 6.

**Homeowners are responsible for contacting the LHS irrigation contractor, utilities companies and Brick Township as applicable for all tree plantings and/or removal.**

The homeowner hereby agrees that if any irrigation work **must** be done as a result of these improvements, the homeowner will be responsible for payment due to the Lions Head South Association, Inc. irrigation contractor for the work done.

**ARCHITECTURAL REGULATIONS- III. RESIDENTIAL BUFFER ZONE**

Residential Buffer Zones shall include those sections of property **to the rear or side boundaries** owned by the unit owner and containing trees and/or other vegetation that were preserved and/or planted by the developer.

Residential Buffer Zones shall be left in a natural state, except that dead vegetation shall be removed. Trimming shall be the unit owners' responsibility.

No trees or shrubs shall be removed from the Residential Buffer Zones without the approval of the Architectural Committee, which may include an on-site inspection and consultation.

If overgrown trees/shrubs are removed, and if deemed necessary to preserve the Residential Buffer Zones, and to maintain a privacy screen, as before, suitable replacement evergreen shrubs or small trees shall be required.
